I. TITLE: Maternal Health Program	
II. DESCRIPTION: <p>The Maternal Health Program is the cornerstone program of the DOH MNCHN / RMNCAHN Strategy that focuses on the health needs of the mother and her baby, identifying the risks that threaten their lives in all stages of the pre-pregnancy, pregnancy, labor and delivery and the post-partum cycle.</p> <p>The Program seeks to ensure that appropriate health interventions adequately address and respond to the urgent needs of the mother and her baby, through improved access and utilization of quality care service packages, provided by committed skilled health professionals in appropriate health institutions that meet the standards.</p> <p>The Program seeks to ensure proper and appropriate implementation of program strategies that are in accordance with Policy Guidelines, through coordination, collaboration and synchronization of pertinent activities with various program implementers, Local Government Units, partners and stakeholders, towards achievement of the Sustainable Goals of reducing maternal and neonatal mortality and ensuring quality of life to mother and baby by 2030.</p>	
A. VISION	All mothers and babies accessing and utilizing quality maternal and newborn services for optimum safety and healthy lives.
B. MISSION	To lead and harmonize maternal program implementation to enhance equitable, accessible, quality maternal package service delivery through dynamic partnership and shared advocacy, responsibility and accountability.
